

Important Information

Admission process for PG Diploma Programmes

(Session 2024-25)

1. After the declaration of the entrance examination result by NTA, the interested candidates are required to register for the counselling. (link provided separately)
2. While filling the registration form, candidates should read and fill their preferences carefully for the Courses, Language and Campus. Any request for change(s) in the preference(s) will not be accepted after the submission of the registration form.
3. Candidates are required to submit the registration fee as per the details given below:

General: Rs.1,500/-

EWS/OBC/SC/ST/PH: Rs.1,000/-

4. Each candidate will be allowed to float up to three lists, after which the candidate has to finalize the seat as per candidate's merit.
5. After finalizing the course the candidate has to pay Rs.20,000/- as an advance(token) amount of tuition fee to freeze the seat in the preferred course. The remaining balance will have to be paid within the stipulated date and time.
6. It is mandatory for each candidate to submit High School Certificate for verification of the Date of Birth.
7. It is mandatory for the candidates who have completed their graduation to submit the final graduation mark-sheet. The candidates awaiting their graduation final result need to submit their required documents within the stipulated date and time.
8. If the candidates belonging to the reserved category are not able to submit the certificate then they can give the undertaking at the time of admission and submit the category certificate within the stipulated date and time

9. Age Limit

General: Born on 01.08.1999 or later (Maximum 25 years as on 01st August 2024).

OBC: Born on 01.08.1996 or later (Maximum 28 years as on 01st August 2024).

SC/ST/PH: Born on 01.08.1994 or later (Maximum 30 years as on 01st August 2024).


